Section 1: Reading Comprehension

Read the following short text in French:

- **1.** What is the main purpose of naturalisation in France?
 - a. To get a job
 - b. To become a French citizen
 - c. To get a passport quickly
 - d. To pay fewer taxes

- **2.** Since 2026, what is required for the naturalisation process?
 - a. Owning property
 - b. Having a family in France
 - c. Speaking French at B2 level
 - d. Voting in elections



Section 2: Listening Comprehension

Choose one recent episode (about 10 minutes) and listen carefully.

After listening, answer these questions in English or French:

- 1. What are the main topics discussed in the news?
- 2. Choose one of the stories: what details can you remember about it?
- 3. Did the journalist give only facts, or did they also include opinions?



Section 3: Writing Task

Write a short formal email in French (100–150 words).

TOPIC:

You would like to register for a French language course at your local Alliance Française. Write to ask for course times, level assessment, and cost.



Section 4: Speaking Task

Imagine you are in a naturalisation interview. Answer the following questions in French. You can record yourself or write your responses.

- 1. Présentez-vous en quelques phrases (nom, âge, nationalité, métier, où vous habitez).
- 2. Pourquoi voulez-vous devenir citoyen(ne) français(e)?
- 3. Quelles sont, selon vous, les valeurs importantes de la République française ?
- 4. Parlez d'un sujet d'actualité qui vous intéresse.



Scoring Guide

Section 1: Reading

2 correct answers = likely B1–B2 1 correct = A2–B1 0 correct = A1–A2

Section 2: Listening

If you understood the topic, general tone, and main ideas = likely B2

If you needed the transcript or could only catch a few words = A2–B1

Section 3: Writing

Check your text:

• Are there connectors (par exemple, cependant, donc)?

- Is it grammatically correct and formal?
- Did you include questions, polite formulas?

If yes to 2-3 = B2If not sure or basic expressions only = A2–B1

Section 4: Speaking

If you can answer fluently, using past and future tenses, with personal opinions = likely B2

If you hesitate or only use short/basic phrases = A2–B1
